

Wait List - FAQs

What is a wait list?

A wait list is a list that you can add yourself to when a class is full.

How do I add myself on a waiting list?

How am I registered from a waiting list?

If a seat opens, the system will automatically register you into the wait listed class.

When will I get notified?

Once you are successfully enrolled from the waiting list, a confirmation email will be sent to your FIU email account.

If I wait list a class, am I guaranteed a seat?

No. This is just a way for you to wait in line until a seat opens.

Will I be charged for the class I'm wait listing?

No. You will only be charged tuition for the wait listed class when you have been successfully registered.

When can I wait list for a class?

Beginning Spring 2018, November 13th – January 5th.

Can I remove myself from a waiting list?

Yes. You can use the drop option to drop yourself from a wait listed class.

Can I get stuck on a list?

Yes. You can remain on a waiting list if:

- No seats are available
- You enrolled in another course that conflicts with the same meeting time as the wait listed course
- You have enrolled in the maximum number of allowable credits for the term.
- You enrolled in one section and wait listed for another section. (You must use the SWAP option instead)

Can I swap into a waitlisted class?

Yes. Swapping into a wait listed class will let you instruct the system to drop you from your enrolled class only when you have been successfully enrolled into your preferred wait listed class.

Please Note: The only way to hold a seat in one section of a class and then be moved into a different section is through the Swap feature.
